Training will be conducted by the Quad Cities National Weather Service Office.

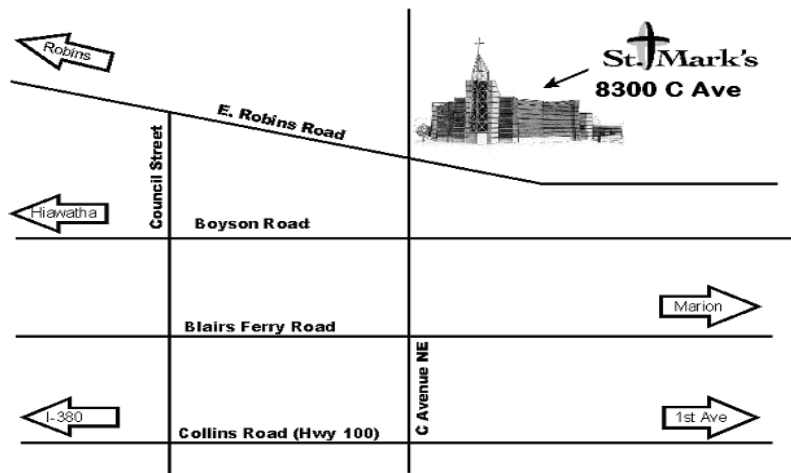
